Stage - A raised platform on which theatrical performances are presented

Shakesphere - English playwright and poet whose body of works is considered the greatest in English literature

Brass - The trumpet belongs to this instrument family

Orchestra - instrumental ensemble that contains sections of string, brass, woodwind, and percussion instruments

Water Lilies - French Impressionist Claude Monet made 250 paintings of these flowers that grow on top of a pond

Sculpture - three-dimensional artwork created by shaping or combining hard materials such as stone or marble

Choreography - The art of composing dances

Critic - a person who is professionally engaged in the analysis and interpretation of works of art

Camp- a supervised program for children or teenagers conducted (usually) during the summer months

Ringmaster – the master of ceremonies for a circus

Easel - An upright frame for displaying or supporting an artist's canvas

Circus - a travelling company of performers that may include clowns

Drum - percussion instrument that you play with a stick

Crayon - writing instrument used for coloring books

Song- a musical composition of words and music

Book- the finished product of an author

Ballerina- the principal female dancer of a ballet company

Exhibition- the public display of art in a space such as a gallery
